BACHELOR OF ENGINEERING IN BIOTECHNOLOGY

With a Bachelor of Engineering degree in Biotechnology, you will be able to work in industry within the production fields of medicine, food and the environment. You will obtain professional qualifications of high importance in the development of new products in the area of biotechnical production, wastewater purification or bioenergy. The fifth semester of your studies will be dedicated to a six months internship at an engineering company. Beside getting a practical insight into the work as an engineer, you will also be getting a trainee salary.




